DIL ROWORTH

Dil has lived and worked in Somerset for over 40 years, daughter and sister to artists, living as a child in Wiltshire and Cornwall and as a young adult in Devon, so her roots are very firmly planted in the West Country. She trained as a mature adult at Plymouth University, studying Illustration, as this was the only course that provided the opportunity for regular figurative drawing.

Dil has completed a varied list of illustrative commissions: cards for Somerset County Council, brochures for the Exmoor National Park, Bournemouth Council and others, and an international text book to aid with the teaching of Mandarin Chinese (which was a decidedly odd and rewarding task!) In between there have been other illustrative commissions, including a Christmas card for Woodmansterne Greetings Cards and painting exhibitions throughout the county.

More recently, she has illustrated a brochure of the plants used by the Bach Essence company, and more whacky cartoons for the authors of the Chinese book. It took Dil two and a half years to write and illustrate four books about nearly four hundred wildflowers in Britain (as yet unpublished).
