The talk will illustrate the story of how they came to be sung and the impact they had on the enslaved and on the plantation owners. The talk will conclude with the story of the 'Singing Revolution' where songs played a significant role in Estonia's liberation from the iron grip of the USSR. A key part of the talk will be listening to songs that liberate.
