During March we supported Love Food Hate



Waste's Food Waste Action Week campaign. Research from Love Food Hate Waste has shown that we could reduce food waste by 60,000 tonnes just

Still on the subject of waste, did you know that 21% of the average Somerset bin is food waste?
Reducing food waste at home not only saves you money but helps the environment too. SUEZ
Recycling and Somerset Council offered a fridge thermometer and food caddy liners to our Pantry members.

A Pantry membership for 6 months gives an up to £500 saving on groceries per household. On **1 April**, **the weekly fee goes up from £3.50 to £4.00** which still gets you up to **£30 worth of fresh food**. In addition, it also reduces food waste. Since opening, the Pantry has saved 17.5 tonnes of food that would otherwise have been wasted.
